### 1. Purpose

This policy exists to ensure that all wrestling events are safe, welcoming, and enjoyable for performers, guests, staff, and audience members. By attending an event, all ticket holders and guests agree to follow this policy.

Throughout this policy 'us', 'we' and 'promoters' refers to Venom Championship Wrestling Limited.

### 2. Respectful Behaviour

- All attendees must treat wrestlers, staff, officials, and other audience members with respect at all times.
- Harassment, discrimination, or abuse of any kind will not be tolerated. This includes behaviour related to race, gender, sexuality, disability, religion, or appearance.
- While vocal crowd reactions are part of wrestling culture, threatening language or personal abuse is not acceptable.



### 3. Fan Interaction

- Cheering, booing, chanting, and reacting to the action are encouraged, provided they remain respectful.
- Do not attempt to touch, grab, or interfere with wrestlers, referees, or staff unless explicitly invited as part of the performance. This includes attempting to enter the ring.
- Throwing objects, liquids, or debris toward the ring, performers or other guests is strictly prohibited.

### 4. Safety and Conduct

- Follow all instructions given by event staff and security at all times.
- Remain seated in designated areas unless otherwise permitted.
- Do not enter the ring or restricted areas before, during, or after the event.
- Any behaviour that risks injury or disrupts the event may result in removal without refund.

### 5. Children and Young People

- Unless otherwise stated, children must be supervised by a responsible adult at all times.
- Some events may include loud noise, strong language, or simulated violence. Parents and guardians are responsible for determining suitability.
- Age guidance provided by the promoter or venue must be followed.

### 6. Alcohol and Substances

- Where alcohol is served, attendees are expected to drink responsibly.
- Anyone who is visibly intoxicated or using illegal substances will be refused entry or removed from the venue.
- Bringing illegal substances or alcohol into the venue is not permitted on the premises.



## 7. Recording and Photography

- Personal photography and video clips may be permitted unless otherwise stated. Please ensure you are respectful to anyone around you who may not want to be filmed or photographed.
- Professional recording equipment is not allowed without prior permission from the promoters.
- Any recording for commercial use is strictly prohibited.

## 8. Consequences of Policy Breaches

- Event staff reserve the right to refuse entry or remove any individual who violates this policy.
- Serious incidents may be reported to the venue or local authorities where appropriate.
- No refunds will be issued for removal due to misconduct.

## 9. Acceptance of Policy

Attendance at the event constitutes acceptance of this Audience Policy. The promoters reserves the right to update or amend this policy as necessary.
