Wrestling Event Ticket Purchases and Attendance

These Terms and Conditions (“Terms”) apply to all ticket purchases and attendance at wrestling events promoted and delivered by **Venom Championship Wrestling Limited** (“the Promoter”). By purchasing a ticket and/or attending the Event, you agree to be bound by these Terms.



1. Definitions

- **Event** means the wrestling show organised by Venom Championship Wrestling at the advertised venue and date.
 - **Venue** means the location at which the Event is held.
 - **Ticket Holder** means any person who purchases or holds a valid ticket for the Event and those attending with them.
 - **Promoter/ Us/ We** means Venom Championship Wrestling registered in England and Wales.

2. Ticket Purchase

- 2.1 All tickets are sold subject to availability.
- 2.2 A contract is formed once payment has been received in full. Your ticket is your receipt.
- 2.3 Tickets may only be purchased through authorised sellers approved by us.
- 2.4 We reserve the right to refuse admission if a ticket is deemed invalid, counterfeit, resold in breach of these Terms, or damaged.

3. Pricing and Payment

- 3.1 All ticket prices are stated in GBP (£) and may include VAT where applicable.
- 3.2 Additional booking or transaction fees may apply and will be displayed at checkout.
- 3.3 Full payment must be received before tickets are issued.

4. Refunds and Cancellations

- 4.1 Tickets are non-refundable except in the event of cancellation of the Event.
- 4.2 If the Event is cancelled, we will refund the face value of the ticket only. Booking fees may be non-refundable unless required by law.
- 4.3 If the Event is rescheduled, tickets will remain valid for the new date. If you are unable to attend the rescheduled date, you must contact the Promoter within the stated



timeframe to request a refund.

4.4 No refunds will be issued for failure to attend the Event or if you cancel.

5. Event Changes

5.1 We reserve the right to alter the advertised card, wrestlers, match line-up, or running order without prior notice.

5.2 No refunds will be given due to changes in advertised performers or matches.

5.3 We may alter the start time or Venue where reasonably necessary.

6. Admission and Attendance

6.1 We and/or Venue reserve the right to refuse admission or remove any person whose behaviour is deemed unsafe, inappropriate, intoxicated, abusive, or disruptive.

6.2 All attendees must comply with Venue and our rules and regulations.

6.3 Late arrivals may be admitted at an appropriate break in the performance.

6.4 Children under 16 must be accompanied by a responsible adult unless otherwise stated.

7. Prohibited Items

7.1 The following items are strictly prohibited:

- Weapons of any kind
- Illegal substances
- Alcohol not purchased at the Venue
- Pyrotechnics or flares
- Professional recording equipment (unless authorised)

7.2 Bags may be searched upon entry. Refusal to consent to a search may result in denied entry without refund.



8. Health and Safety

8.1 Professional wrestling is a live contact sport. Loud noises, pyrotechnics, and physical action may occur.

8.2 Attendees assume all risks incidental to the Event, including risk of injury from objects leaving the ring area.

8.3 You agree that we accept no liability for loss, theft, or damage to personal property unless caused by negligence.

9. Photography and Recording

9.1 Ticket Holders consent to being photographed, filmed, or recorded as part of the audience.

9.2 We may use such recordings for promotional, marketing, or broadcast purposes without compensation.

9.3 Unauthorised commercial recording or live streaming is strictly prohibited.

10. Conduct

10.1 Anti-social behaviour, harassment, discriminatory language, or violence will not be tolerated. This includes attempts to enter the ring or to make contact with our performers.

10.2 We operate a zero-tolerance policy towards racism, homophobia, sexism, and other forms of discrimination.

10.3 Any person removed from the Venue will not be entitled to a refund. The appropriate action may be taken which includes informing the Police.

11. Resale and Transfer

11.1 Tickets may not be resold for commercial gain without prior written consent from us.

11.2 We reserve the right to cancel tickets resold in breach of this clause.



12. Force Majeure

We shall not be liable for cancellation, delay, or alteration of the Event due to circumstances beyond reasonable control, including but not limited to:

- Government restrictions
 - Severe weather
 - Acts of terrorism
 - Public health emergencies

13. Data Protection

13.1 Personal data will be processed in accordance with the UK General Data Protection Regulation (UK GDPR) and the Data Protection Act 2018.

13.2 Please refer to our Privacy Policy for further details.

14. Liability

14.1 By purchasing tickets to the event, you agree that we will not be held responsible for any accidents, loss, injuries, near misses or death as a result of you attending the event.

15. Governing Law

These Terms shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of England and Wales.

Any disputes shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England and Wales.
